It's also worth mentioning here that you won't need the same provider to buy your domain name from and host your website simultaneously.
- **3. Acquire:** As soon as you get your domain name registered, you'll need to acquire the names of the primary and secondary name servers of your web host. You also have to save the data somewhere safe. There should be a clause on the subject in the FAQ section of the site. If you don't find it there, look for a category, such as "DNS," "domain



name," or "domain name transfer." No one should underestimate this requirement. You'll need the data to point the domain name to the web host.

4. Set it up: Conclude the procedure by setting up your hosting and site. If you don't have a host yet, the registrar should be able to set up a temporary website with your domain name specifically for you. You should utilize the time you get to secure the domain name before you lose it once and for all. If you need to learn more about the process of setting up a website, just browse the internet.
